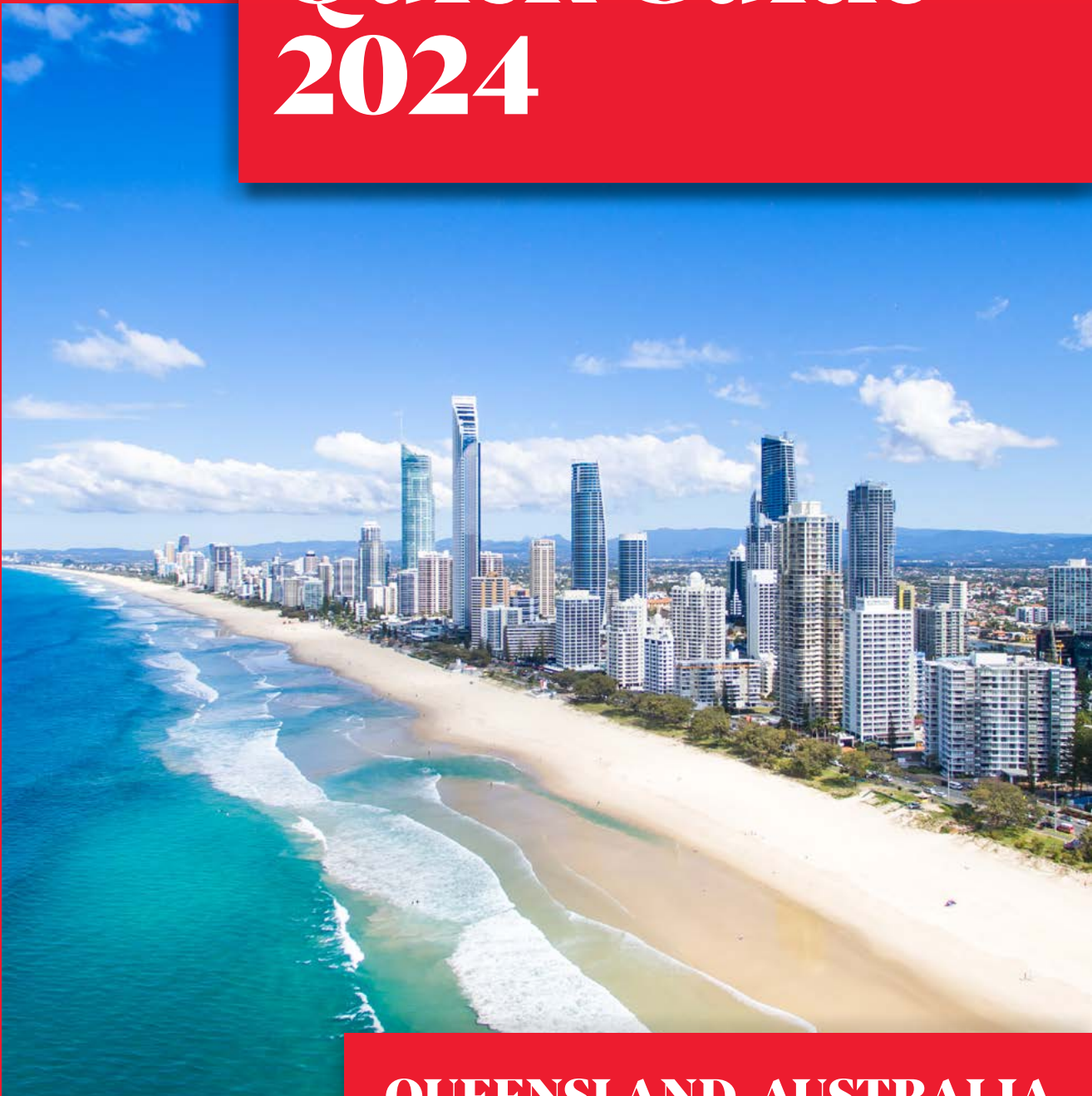

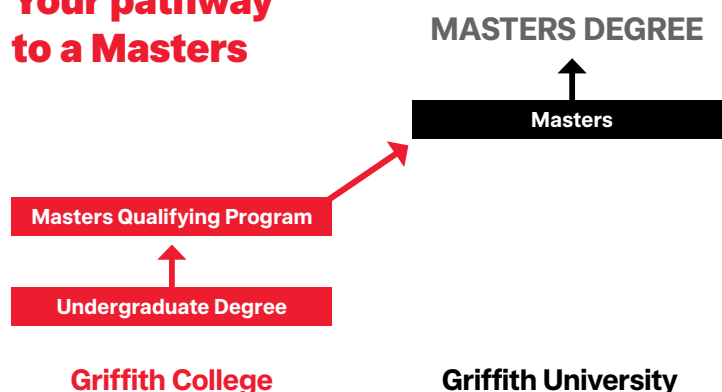

BRISBANE 2032 OLYMPIC GAMES

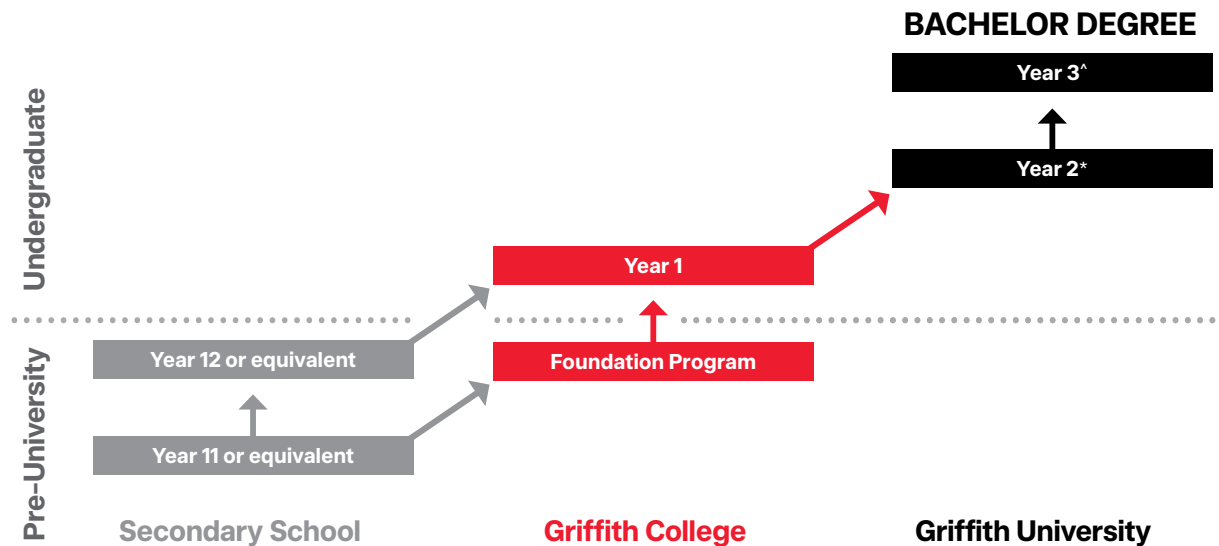

CAMPUS LOCATIONS

Griffith College is located in South East Queensland, on the east coast of Australia.

We have two campuses, less than an hour apart, situated in key locations in this thriving part of the world.

Just a short distance from the city centre of Brisbane (Queensland's capital), is our **Mt Gravatt campus**. This campus is located on the fringe of Toohy Forest and offers panoramic views of the city.

Only an hour's drive south is our **Gold Coast campus**, within easy reach of world-famous beaches and relaxed entertainment.

The campus that you attend will depend upon the study program that you choose.

Both Griffith College zones are part of Griffith University's wider campus, meaning our students are immersed in university life from day one.

This adds to the sense of confidence and familiarity that students feel throughout their time at Griffith.



HOW TO APPLY

There are 5 simple steps to applying for a place at Griffith College.



- 1 Choose the program you want to study**

- 2 Check the entry requirements**
Check the **academic entry requirements** and the **English entry requirements** specific to your chosen program.
- 3 Prepare supporting documentation**
Include certified copies of your academic and English exam results (translated into English if needed) plus a copy of your passport photo page.

- 4 Apply through a representative**
An international agent or provider assists with your application and visa.

- 5 Accept your offer**
If you are successful in securing an offer with us, congratulations! Read your offer letter and make sure you meet all conditions stated in the letter, pay the tuition deposit fee, sign and email the acceptance form. This will secure your place!
