STEP ONE

LOGGING IN

In your Griffith College email, click on the unique link provided to log in to the Diagnostic Test.

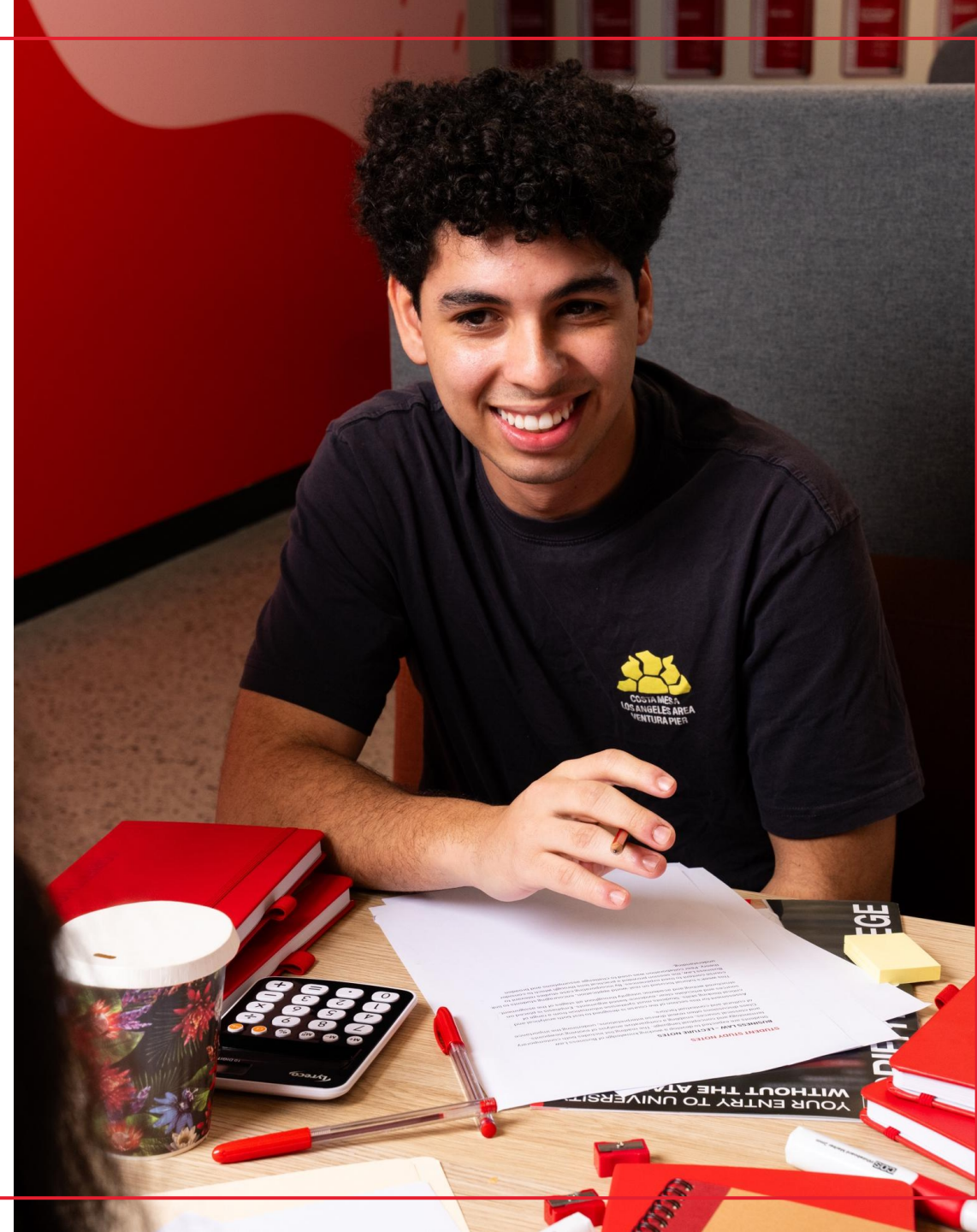
Find and click on your name, and enter your password

Your password is your birthdate backwards.
For example, 28th December 2002 = 20021228

STEP TWO

BEGINNING THE TEST

Once you log in, click on "Start Diagnostic" to begin.

Read instructions carefully and complete the first test as soon as possible.

There are four tests in total, so take your time and remember to have a break in between.

Diagnostic Instructions

This diagnostic is a quick test to figure out what maths you already know. Try your best, but don't worry if you don't know the answer, it's about what you already know!



Use working paper

Use a spare piece of paper if you need to work something out



Skip if you don't know

If you don't know how to work out the answer, just skip the question



Don't get help from friends

We want to find out what you know, not others in your class



No calculator needed

If you are allowed a calculator to complete a question, one will appear on screen.



STEP THREE

LOGGING IN TO TEST 2, 3, 4

An email has been sent to you with three codes, used for logging back in to the test.

Use them in sequence.

For example, you receive:

Code 1: 12345
Code 2: 45723
Code 3: 23452

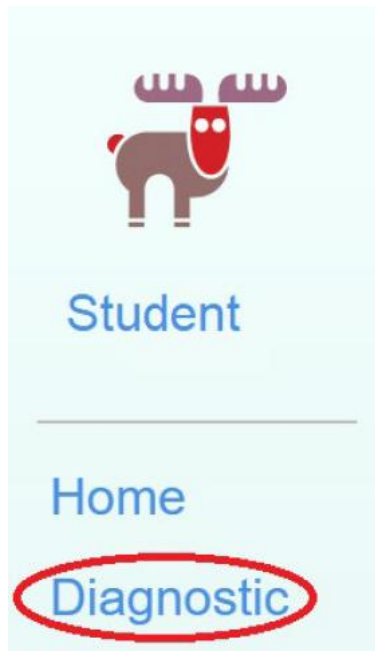
Use 12345 before 45723, and use code 45723 before 23452.



STEP FOUR

COMPLETING TEST 2, 3, 4

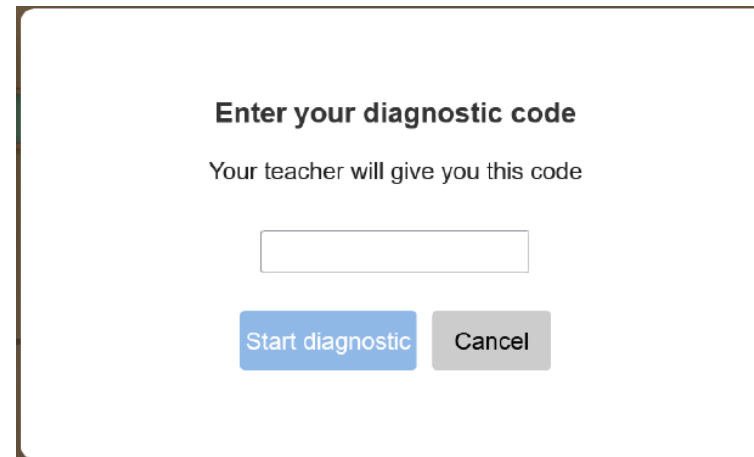
1. Find the diagnostic test as shown in the picture.
