4 Apply directly via our website or through an agent representative

An international agent or provider assists with your application and visa. Find an approved Griffith College representative in your country on our website. Alternatively, apply directly. Scan for more information about both options.



5 Accept your offer

If you are successful in securing an offer with us, congratulations! Read your offer letter and make sure you meet all conditions stated in the letter, pay the tuition deposit fee, sign and email the acceptance form. This will secure your place!

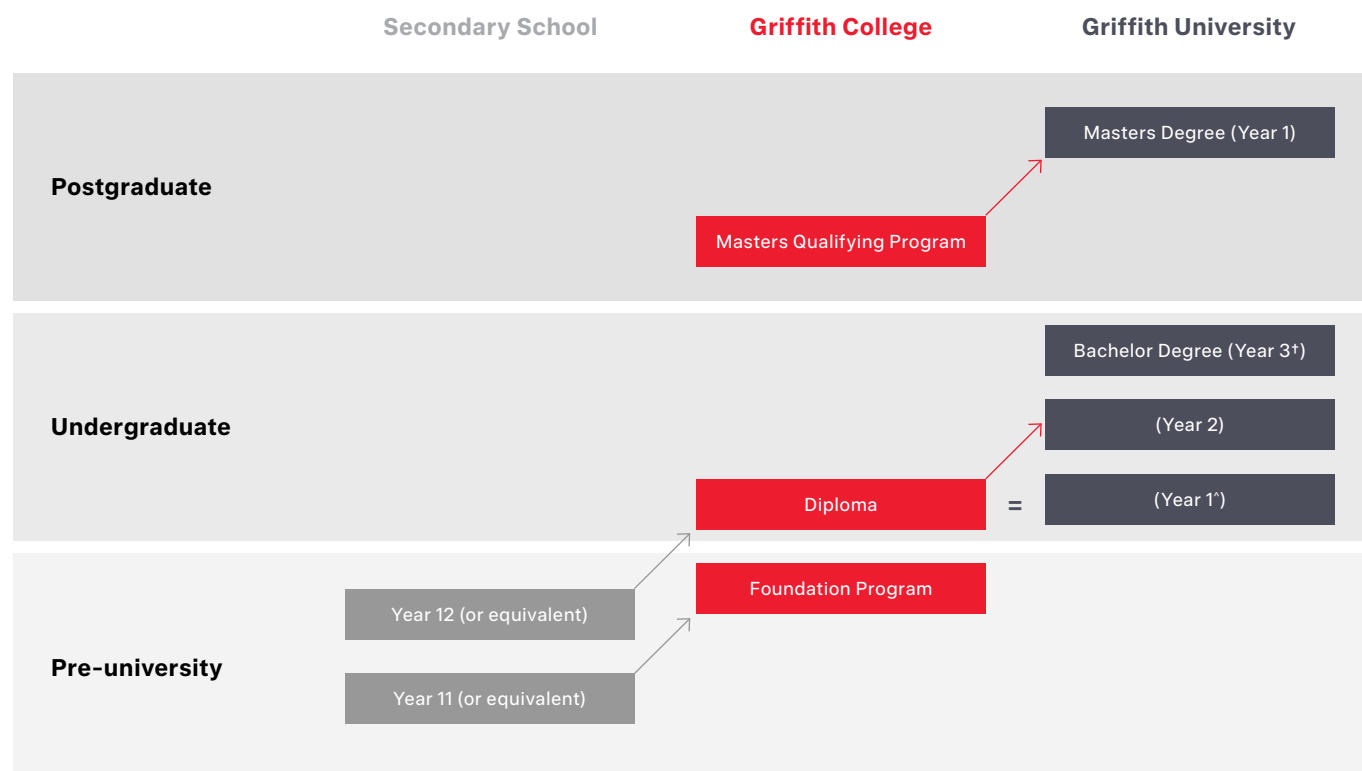

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS

English entry requirements for Foundation and Diploma pathways start from an overall IELTS score of 5.5 (with no band below 5.0) and range up to IELTS 7.5 for Educational Studies.

Masters Qualifying Program requires an overall IELTS score of 6.0 (with no band below 5.5).
