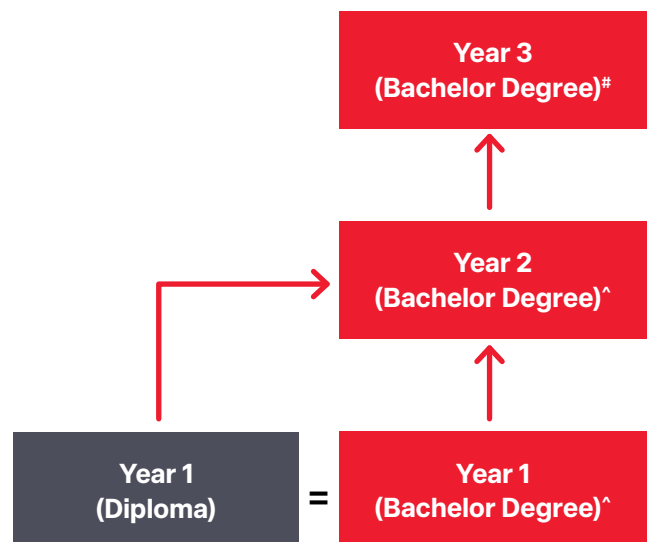
**Our mission is to get you to your dream degree without delay. No ATAR required!**

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

### No ATAR Required

We believe in supporting students to succeed at university, regardless of their ATAR or past academic performance.

Our programs are designed to help you develop the skills and confidence you need to thrive in higher education.

### ENTRY BASED ON ACADEMIC EXPERIENCE

Whether you're a recent Year 12 graduate or have been out of school for some time, you can apply if you have gained one of the following within the past 10 years:

- Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) or an equivalent qualification from another state or territory.
- A completed Certificate III or higher qualification.
- An ATAR (though this is not a requirement for entry).

### ENTRY BASED ON WORK AND LIFE EXPERIENCE

If you haven't completed a formal qualification, or if it's been more than 10 years since you did, don't worry!

Your life and work experience matter. We recognise the value of everything you've learned outside the classroom, and we're here to help you take the next step.

Once you submit your application, you'll be invited to a friendly online or phone interview with a staff member from the College. This is a chance for us to get to know you, understand your goals, and explore how we can support you on your study journey.
